



The Autumn Term addendum to the uniform policy has been reviewed. Full Governors have adopted the following policy as the full uniform policy from January 2021 onwards.

High standards and a positive work ethic are central to a successful future. Our school uniform creates a sense of belonging to our school community and sets the tone for all our work.

In the Autumn Term we relaxed the need to have a school badge on trousers and polo shirts.

Polo shirts need a school badge. The school uniform policy from January 2021 will require a polo shirt to have a school badge. **Please be aware that the purple badge is being phased out and replaced with the blue badge for year 10 and 11 over the next two academic years.** *We will support any parent struggling to purchase a polo with a badge.

Trousers do not need a badge – From January 2021 we will be phasing out the requirement to have a badge on school trousers. Badges on trousers will still be acceptable until a student needs to buy new trousers.

Students in years 7 to 11 this year are required to wear the following school uniform:

- **An appropriate face covering (we advise carrying a spare)**
- Polo Shirt: From January year 7, 8 and 9 will need a blue badge on their white polo shirt.
From January year 10 and 11 will need a purple badge on their white polo shirt.
- Jumper / Cardigan: Black Bridlington School sweatshirt / cardigan with a blue badge for year 7, 8, 9 and purple badge for year 10 and 11.
No other jumper to be worn in school.
- Trousers: Plain black school trousers (no badge required) *Note this is a permanent change to the uniform policy*
No leggings, no short versions at ankle, no coloured belts, no jeans
- Shoes / trainers: Low heeled, plain black (no coloured flashes, coloured soles or logos)

It is advisable that clothing is clearly marked with the student's name in case of loss.

PE kit:

We are also phasing out the Year 10 and 11 PE red polo shirt over the next two years.

From January students will be expected to wear:

- Navy polo shirt with red collar and arms for year 7, 8 and 9.
- Red polo shirt with navy arms for year 10 and 11.
- Navy blue or black shorts (not cycling)
- Navy blue or black tracksuit bottoms or sports leggings
- Long red socks
- Trainers
- Football boots (certain sports), Gum shield (certain sports) , Shin pads (certain sports)
- Optional: Navy hoodie with school badge. Waterproof sports jacket with school badge.

We do not allow students to wear jewellery, except for one stud per ear for those with pierced ears. No other body piercings are allowed including clear bars. Neither are ear plugs.

No accessories to nails including acrylics, varnishes, gels, jewels etc.

Hair should be clean and well-kept - extreme or unusual styles/unnatural colours are not acceptable.

Make-up should be subtle, if worn. Any student wearing excessive make-up will be asked to remove it.

The Headteacher will have the final decision on the definition of extreme/unusual/unnatural hair styles and make-up.
