Return to School Letter for 6th Form - March 2021

Dear student,

We can't wait to welcome back our 6th Form.

What day can the 6th Form come in for their 1st Lateral Flow Test?

Come though the top gate to the Sports Hall on Monday 8th March. Bring your face covering. You will go to the sixth form learning centre straight after your test and your result will be text / emailed to you by the NHS test and trace service. You will need to bring your mobile phone.

Year 13 arrive between	9am to 9.30am
Year 12 arrive between	9.30am to 10am

You should have already registered on the NHS Lateral Flow Testing App. Do not worry if you have not done so we can help with this on the day or you can contact Mr Pick or Julie for help.

What happen after my Lateral Flow Test?

You will need to maintain your 2m social distance in the learning centre. You will receive your test result by email and text from the NHS test and trace service. If your test is negative you are OK able to join the 6th form bubble in the normal way and go to your mentor room for your mentoring appointment. Here your mentor will have an open and honest discussion about where you are up to with your work and what you need to support you going forwards. You will also be given a reminder of how we keep each other safe by following our Covid safe procedures, rules and the one-way system.

What lessons will be running week beginning 8th March?

Monday 8th March – none – testing and mentoring Tuesday 9th March – lessons start at 10.00am (because the rest of the school is in tutor time) Wednesday 10th March – lesson start at 10.00am (because the rest of the school is in tutor time) From Thursday 11th March the whole school will be following the normal timetable.

Lateral Flow Test 3	Tuesday 16 th March	1.30pm after lunch	Sports Hall

6th Form will need to leave site straight after their test. Results for all lateral flow tests will be text / emailed to 6th form directly from the NHS test and trace service.

Covid-19 Symptoms

It is really important that you do not come to Bridlington 6th From <u>if you or anyone in your household is showing symptoms of Covid-19 or is waiting for a test</u> and your household self-isolates:

- A new and continuous cough
- High Temperature
- Loss or change in sense of taste or smell

Please do inform the school if anyone in your household has symptoms, is awaiting a test or has tested positive by calling 01262 607393 or emailing office@bridlingtonschool.org.uk.

Finally, as you are aware school attendance is compulsory for sixth form from Monday 8th March 2021and we will of course be following the government guidance. I would like to remind you that we are keen to work with all our families to support your child's return to school as we were when we returned in September.
