

MFL Spring 2 Home Learning information

Overview of learning:

Students will be taking part in a broad and balanced curriculum, listed are the topics each year group will be engaging with this half term

Year 7 – German – Pupils will be continuing to learn German by learning about the different cultural elements that make up German and German-speaking countries.

Year 8 – French – Pupils will be learning to talk about where they live and describe their town in French.

Year 9 – French – Pupils will be learning to describe and explain their future ambitions in French.

Year 10 – French – Pupils are continuing with the previous module of Holidays, learning about a broad range of topics such as problems on holiday that incorporate transactional vocabulary as well as written accounts.

Year 10 – German – Pupils are learning to talk about jobs and work-experience, along with their plans and hopes for the future.

Year 11 – Spanish – Pupils are continuing to review and revise their Learning Journey from Y9 to present across all topics and themes in preparation for their exams. Spring 2 focuses on Theme 2: Local, National, International and Global Areas of Interest.

Working online:

Students in KS3 will receive two lessons per week as they would in school. Year 10 French pupils will receive three lessons, Year 10 German pupils will receive two lessons, and Year 11 Spanish pupils will receive four lessons. There will be a Loom video explaining the task alongside a written description on Class Charts and the lesson resources will be attached to the task.

Physical work packs:

Year groups 7 – 10 will receive a Home Learning booklet to fill out, with a page dedicated to each lesson. Each lesson page will also have an answer page in the booklet and space for pupils to write their responses to the tasks. For Year 11 an AQA GCSE Revision guide and workbook has been provided for each pupil. Home learning booklets have been created that guide pupils through their revision, lesson by lesson, using the resources provided by the school.

Timescales:

As per their school timetable, KS3 pupils will have two Home Learning tasks for MFL on Class Charts per week, Year 10 French pupils will have three lessons, Year 10 German pupils will have two lessons, and Year 11 Spanish pupils will have four lessons.

Feedback (via Class Charts):

Students will receive at least one specific WWW and one specific EBI per Home Learning task submission within 24 hours of the submission deadline. Students will be rewarded for their submissions using Class Charts points - 2 points will be awarded for home learning attempted or 10 points if the submission meets the expected standard.
