

Geography Spring 2 Home Learning information

Overview of learning

Year 7 - Students will be working on the topic of '**Global Development**'. This has been moved forward in the students' learning journey due to the need to teach Map Skills in person. Students have a work booklet, with a page to focus on per lesson. The aim is to embed literacy skills in addition to incorporating command words. A range of questions types are included to cater for different abilities.

Year 10 - Students will be continuing to work on the topic '**Urban Issues and Challenges**'. Students have a work booklet and an information booklet and are directed to specific pages to complete per lesson. The aim is to embed literacy skills in addition to incorporating command words. A range of questions types are included to cater for different abilities.

Year 11 - Students will be working on the **Revision Booklet Paper 2**. Students are directed to specific pages to complete per lesson. The aim is to embed literacy skills in addition to incorporating command words. A range of questions types are included to cater for different abilities. Students use their own knowledge to answer the questions/complete tasks and then use the Y11 Revision Pack to fill in gaps in their knowledge.

Year 12 and 13 - Students will receive a variety of live lessons on Teams, Loom lessons and independent working. Year 12 will work on the topics: '**Contemporary Urban Environments**' and '**Coasts**'. Year 13 will revise the topics: '**Global Systems and Global governance**' and '**Coasts**'.

Working online

Year 7 – 10: A Loom video has been provided to support students in the completion of the home learning booklet and explanations of how to answer each question with time stamps directing students to the appropriate section. Students are directed to complete a specific page/tasks in the booklet per lesson. Students can either write on the booklet in the space provided, or complete tasks on a computer or paper. Class teachers can also be contacted via Class Charts for additional support.

Year 11: A Loom video has been provided to support students in the use of effective revision strategies and how to use the revision booklet. Students can either write on the booklet in the space provided, or complete tasks on a computer or paper. Class teachers can also be contacted via Class Charts for additional support.

Year 12 and 13: All home learning will be shared with students via Teams and Class Charts. Students can communicate with their Geography teacher via Teams, email or Class Charts. A-Level teachers will feedback to students via Teams or Class Charts.

Physical work packs

Year 7 and 8: Students receive a physical copy of the Home Learning booklet and can write their answers in the space provided.

Year 9: Students receive a physical copy of the Home Learning booklet and can write their answers in the space provided. For the '**Coasts**' topic an information booklet and a work booklet has been provided. The answers to questions in the work booklet can be found in the information booklet. The work booklet specifies which pages to find the relevant information on.

Year 10: Students receive a physical copy of the information booklet and work booklet. In the work booklet students can write their answers in the space provided. The work booklet specifies which pages to find the relevant information on.

Year 11: Students receive a physical copy of the work booklet and have a copy of the Y11 Revision Pack.

Timescales

KS3 – 2 lessons per week; one page of the booklet per lesson.

Year 10 – A band 3 lessons per week, B band 2 lessons per week; a minimum of one page of the booklet per lesson.

Year 11 – 4 lessons per week; a minimum of one page of booklet per lesson.

Feedback (via Class Charts):

Students will receive at least one specific WWW and one specific EBI per Home Learning task submission within 24 hours of the submission deadline. Students will be rewarded for their submissions using Class Charts points - 2 points will be awarded for home learning attempted or 10 points if the submission meets the expected standard.
