



In 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 we won a national SSAT Excellence Award for the progress our students made between Year 7 and Year 11.

### Y11 Results for 2017-2018

- The school's Progress 8 score is 0.12 (All state-funded schools nationally is -0.02)
- The school's Attainment 8 score is 45.7 (Nationally 44.5%)
- Percentage of pupils who have achieved a strong pass (Grade 5) in English and Maths at the end of KS4 is 42% (Nationally 40.2%)
- Percentage of pupils entered for the English Baccalaureate is 0% (Nationally 35.2%)
- Percentage of students staying in education or employment after KS4 is 93% (Nationally 94%)
