

Examination Results 2016

In 2013, 2014 and 2015 we won a national SSAT Excellence Award for the progress our students made between Year 7 and Year 11, which places the school in the top 10% of all schools nationally for student progress. We are very likely to win this award for the fourth year running based on the progress our students made in their GCSEs in 2016.
