



In 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 we won a national SSAT Excellence Award for the progress our students made between Year 7 and Year 11.

Y11 Results for 2018-19

- The school's Progress 8 score is -0.01 (All state-funded schools nationally is -0.02)
- The school's Attainment 8 score is 43.0 (Nationally 44.5)
- Percentage of pupils who have achieved a strong pass (Grade 5) in English and Maths at the end of KS4 is 34% (Nationally 40.2%)
- Percentage of pupils entered for the English Baccalaureate is 6% (Nationally 35.2%)
- Percentage of students who continue in education or training, or move on to employment at the end of KS4 is 93% (Nationally 94%)
