The sixth form had two great speakers this week. An officer from army careers came to talk about the opportunities available to 18-year-old school leavers and we also had an inspirational speaker to talk about the varied career paths available in the NHS.

Sparks

On Thursday, different groups in year 7 will be working with Hull University throughout the day as part of their Sparks programme.

Sparks is a program from the University of Hull designed to get KS3 and KS4 students informed about what higher education is, what you can study and the impact that can have on careers and employability. This is achieved through group work, and they have kindly opened this up to the entire year group for years 7 - 10.

Each year look at a different aspect of higher education: in year 7, they look at the transition from secondary to university in comparison to their own transition from primary to secondary; in year 8 they look at different subjects available at university, linked to their own GCSE options; in year 9, they get to go to Hull University for the day; in year 10 they look at graduate careers and how you can use your degree; and in year 11 they did study skills.

We focus on providing a wide range of opportunities to develop and stretch students' talents and interests. We have over 40 lunch and after-school clubs running this half term, such as sports clubs, performing arts clubs and homework clubs. We encourage all students to give a new club a go this half term and grab every opportunity!
