The students who study French started the week off in France! We visited Le Touquet and explored the war memorial in Etaples, a boulangerie and a chocolate factory. The following day we visited the Sea Life Centre. Students were given the opportunity to experience French culture and use their language skills. They were impeccably behaved and for some it was the first time on a ferry and abroad. Thank you to the staff who supervised the students abroad for the first time since 2019!

On Monday 10th July, we had the Dramatic Theatre Company in school delivering their performance 'One of My Friends' to our year 7 and 8 students. The performance explored key themes from the Life Skills curriculum: Mental health and emotional wellbeing, the use of alcohol/drugs and smoking/vaping. Following each of the characters' stories pupils were encouraged to ask the characters questions, discuss their ideas and offer the character their advice, as if they were 'one of my friends'.

On Tuesday 11th July, year 12 visited CU Scarborough. They explored the campus through a treasure hunt and attended workshops on business communication and cybersecurity.

On Thursday a group of year 8 and 9 students visited GCHQ Scarborough for a languages outreach day where they learnt about the importance of Learning languages. They took on a series of challenges using translation and deciphering in French, German, Spanish and Russian to produce an intelligence report about an imminent cyberattack. We also had our year 10 Geographers visiting Hornsea and Hull to complete a range of coastal and urban fieldwork techniques. As part of our growing network of local employer links, our year 10 Engineering students also visited AB Graphics to experience a career in engineering first-hand.
